6th Sunday of Easter Year C

Today's gospel reading is a continuation of the last supper discourse of Jesus recorded by St John (Jn 13:31, to Jn 17) which was partly read last Sunday. This Sunday's periscope is part of the conclusion, where Jesus speaks about his departure, and in that context how he will remain present to his community. He has two gifts to the church: The Holy Spirit and peace. The Spirit is the one who continues the teaching of Jesus by keeping it in the memory of his disciples, and does not introduce a new or additional teaching. Peace is the gift that enables them to remain in love with each other and with the Father – God's Shalom.

Nevertheless, within this discourse, Jesus invites His disciples to remain in his word. This command is dovetailed in the sense that it does not only implies 'to keep' but also 'to be formed'. In order to keep, they must listen and when they listen, they will be formed, but by who? The advocate – the Holy Spirit. In the same way, Jesus invites us to listen to his word, keep it and be formed by the Holy Spirit. For when we listen to the word of God and keep God's commandments, our hearts can begin to be touched by the

Holy Spirit in wonderful and special ways. Let us try to respond to these invitations today. May we remain in Christ's word.
